

Petite Puppy Vaccine Plan

First Visit - 8 weeks

- DAP #1- Vaccine to prevent the Distemper virus, Adenovirus and Parvo Virus
- Bordetella Intranasal- Protection against "kennel cough"
- Deworming- Treatment of internal parasites frequently obtained from their mother
- **FREE** Puppy Pack (When Available) Your puppy's first doses of heartworm, flea and tick preventatives.

Second Visit- 12 weeks

- DAP #2- Booster vaccine from first visit
- Rabies- 1 year vaccine

Third Visit- 16 weeks

- DAP #3- Final booster vaccine
- Lepto #1- Bacterial infection that attacks kidneys and liver. Carried and spread in the urine of wildlife.
- Lyme #1- Bacterial infection that affects joints, internal organs and energy level. Carried and spread through ticks.

TECHNICIAN APPOINTMENT

- Lepto #2 Final booster vaccine
- Lyme #2 Final booster vaccine

At each visit your puppy will receive a through nose to toes and ears to rears exam to ensure your pup is developing appropriately, we also offer a complimentary nail trim at each visit.

Spay/Neuter- Usually between 6-8 months of age. Helps to prevent many behavioral and medical issues that commonly affect intact dogs.

<u>GAH Parasite Prevention Options:</u> flea/tick product + Heartgard/ProHeart = complete protection

- Frontline Gold--monthly topical (flea/tick)
- Nexgard –Monthly chew tab (flea/tick): 8 weeks 6 months
- Simparica--monthly chew tab (flea/tick): 6 months of age & older
- Heartgard Plus--Monthly chew tab to prevent heartworm/deworming
- ProHeart Injection Annual shot to prevent heartworm/provide deworming
