#### Kitten Vaccine Plan

## First Visit- 8 weeks


- Feline Leukemia (FeLV) and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV) Testing
- FVRCP #1- Vaccination for multiple agents that cause upper respiratory infections
- FeLV #1- Vaccination for a disease that will compromise a feline's immune system
- Deworming- Treating for intestinal parasites frequently obtained from their mother
- **FREE** Kitten Pack Your kittens first doses of heartworm, flea and tick preventatives.

#### Second Visit- 12 weeks

- FVRCP #2- Booster vaccine from first visit
- FeLV #2- Booster vaccine from first visit.

### Third Visit- 16 weeks

- FVRCP #3- Final booster vaccination
- Rabies- 1 year vaccine



We also offer a complimentary nail trim at each visit.

**Spay/Neuter**- Usually between 6-8 months of age. Helps to prevent many behavioral and medical issues that commonly affect intact cats

# **Parasite Prevention Options:**

- Frontline Gold-Monthly topical (flea/ticks)
- Revolution-Monthly topical (flea/heartworm/dewormer/ear mites)
